



Eco-Schools Global Scrapbook campaign

Instructions for participants

Welcome to join the Eco-Schools Global Scrapbook campaign! In the campaign, self-made scrapbooks will travel around the world from one Eco-School to another between **February and May 2016**. The purpose is to connect Eco-Schools in different countries with each other and make it possible for you to share to each other about your life, local community and Eco-School projects.

Please read these instructions carefully before participating!

How the Global Scrapbook campaign works:

1. All participant schools are divided into scrapbook chains. Each chain is informed by email about the route of their scrapbook: who are the recipients and their addresses, and in which order the scrapbook should travel between the schools.
2. A Finnish Eco-School starts the chain by making a scrapbook, writing and drawing their greetings on its first pages and sending it to the first recipient on the scrapbook chain.
3. The second/third/fourth/etc. school receives the scrapbook, writes and draws their greetings to its next pages and sends the scrapbook to the next school in the chain. Along the way the teachers may interact via e-mail as well as share their stories in a Facebook group.
4. Finally the scrapbook returns to the school it originally left from. In the end the scrapbook will be scanned/photographed so that everyone in the scrapbook chain will get to see the final result. Some of the scrapbooks will also be uploaded in the Internet to be shared for inspiration to other schools around the world.

Instructions for receiving and sending the scrapbook:

- In order to keep on schedule, **each participant should send the scrapbook forward to its next destination within one week from receiving the scrapbook!** So one week is the maximum time you are allowed to use designing and crafting the book.
- **When you receive the scrapbook and when you send it forward, please always notify the other teachers in your scrapbook chain by email!** This way everyone in the chain will be kept on track about where the scrapbook currently is going and when to expect it arriving.
- When sending the scrapbook, please select a mailing option that normally takes max. two weeks to reach the destination (if possible - outside-Europe countries may be an exception).
- Bear in mind that it's unfortunately always possible that the mail gets lost on its way. We suggest that you take photographs of the pages made by you before sending the scrapbook, so in case it gets lost, you can still send those pages electronically.

Ideas for the scrapbook content:

The artistic style of crafting the scrapbook pages is free, so use your skills and imagination to plan it together with the kids/pupils! On the next pages you find a couple of inspirational pictures of how the scrapbook pages could look like.

Because the campaign is about connecting Eco-Schools around the world, please use some pages of the scrapbook to tell about the environmental work in your school, for example sharing your recent Eco-school activities and achievements! In addition to that, you can include on your pages for example some of the following (but feel free to add your own ideas too):

- introduce yourselves and your class/school
- introduce your hometown and country
- write something in your own language and give a translation in English or with pictures
- add some stories, pictures or drawings about things that you care about
- write or draw something that will make the recipients happy!

How many pages of the scrapbook may we use? This you will have to count yourself: count the remaining blank pages on the scrapbook you received and divide it by the number of schools still left in your chain (including you). The result you get is the maximum number of pages you are allowed to use. Please use both sides of the paper! 😊

Privacy issues to take into account:

Be aware that all of the scrapbooks may be scanned and uploaded into the Internet at the end of their world tour. If you want to write any full names of the kids/pupils, email addresses or other private information in the scrapbook, please list them on a separate page at the end of your scrapbook section, so that page can be left out if the scrapbook is uploaded into the Internet. Please also ask permission from parents for using photographs of the kids/pupils in the scrapbook.




